Community Updates

RV Parking Amendment- The Board of Directors voted at the January 28, 2009 meeting to form a committee to create the verbiage of the possible amendment to our CC&R's, amending the amount of time an RV may be parked in our community. 3 homeowners volunteered at the meeting to spear-head the amendment verbiage. An update will be made at the next meeting on April 30. Just a reminder, in order for the Amendment to pass, we will need 91 affirmative votes out of the 136 homeowners in our community.

Homeowner Reminders



Bulk Trash—Please do not place your bulk trash out earlier than the city allows.

Dogs on a Leash—several homeowners are allowing their dogs to run without a leash in the greenbelt area. This is against the CC&R's as well as Town of Gilbert code. Please keep your dogs on their leashes.



Inoperable Cars—Please do not store inoperable cars in your driveway.

Batting/Sport Cages—please make sure to submit for architectural approval for a batting/'sport cage. Anything that shows above the fence needs architectural approval.

Community Crime Alert

Operation S.M.A.R.T Driver. The Gilbert Police Department would like to notify our community that several vehicle burglaries have been occurring in our area. Please be a **S.M.A.R.T** Driver and remember these very important tips when leaving your vehicle!!!

S = Secure your vehicle inside your garage or park in a well lit area. Your vehicle is more vulnerable out in the open. Try not to park street side. Park in your driveway or near your apartment so that the vehicle can be viewed periodically. If you have a garage, park inside and do not forget to close your garage door once inside.

M= Make sure you have taken all of your personal property out of your vehicle. It is important to make certain that you take all of the valuables out of your vehicle when exiting. Burglars love to see items that can be easily carried away, such as: Cash/Change, CD's, Wallets/Purses, Mail, Jewelry, Gym Bags, Tools, Cell Phones, Ipods, Laptops and other electronics.

A= Always make copies of the documents you leave in your glove box and black out your address.

Arizona is number 1 in the nation for identity theft. We need to be extremely conscious of our personal information. Leave only redacted copies of your information in the glove box. If you leave your address on the paperwork and a burglar happens to get a hold of it, they have immediate access to your personal information.

R= Remember to always take your keys, garage opener and radio face plates with you. Many times vehicle thefts begin as a burglary. A criminal finds a vehicle with valuables in it including keys! NEVER LEAVE YOUR KEYS IN YOUR VEHICLE. Take your keys, garage door openers and radio faceplates with you each and every time you leave your vehicle, even when parking inside your own garage. Criminals have electronic garage door decoders which allows them entry into your garage. An open garage door is a crime of opportunity so please keep your garage door closed!

T= Take the time to lock your vehicle and set your car alarm. If you have a vehicle alarm-use it! If you hear a vehicle alarm sounding, pay attention and do not hesitate to contact police to report suspicious activity. The police counts on you to be the eyes and ears of our community!
